

DARK FANTASTIC IN WEDNESDAY SERIES (2022)

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Abstrak

Artikel ini menganalisis *Wednesday series* (2022) yang disutradarai oleh Tim Burton. Tujuan dari penelitian ini yaitu untuk menemukan lima elemen dari dark fantastik di dalam series. Rumusan masalah pada penelitian ini yaitu: “Bagaimana dark fantastik disajikan dalam *Wednesday series* (2022)?”. Analisis dari penelitian ini menggunakan metode kualitatif dan teori lima elemen dark fantastik dari Ebony E. Thomas. Hasil dari penelitian ini menemukan empat elemen dari lima elemen dark fantastik sebagai berikut, spectacle, hesitation, violence, dan haunting. Eksistensi nihilism yang tersirat di dalam series ditunjukkan dalam beberapa scene.

Abstract

This paper analyzes *Wednesday series* (2022) directed Tim Burton. The purpose of this study is to find five element of dark fantastic in the series. The research question of this study is: “How is dark fantastic in *Wednesday series* (2022)?”. Analysis of this study used qualitative studies method and Ebony E. Thomas’ five elements of dark fantastic theory. The result of this study found four elements from five elements as follow, spectacle, hesitation, violence, and haunting. The existential of nihilism that implied in the series reflected in several scene.

INTRODUCTION

Dark fantastic is presenting dark or black character in fantastic story. Fantastic means uncanny or supernatural event in a narrative (Todorov, 1975). Fantasy is a term from Latin, *Phantasticus* that have meaning imaginary or not real. The sub-genre of literature, fantasy combined supernatural elements and something magic that doesn’t exist in realistic (Jackson, 2009). Fantasy means opposite the nature.

Dark or black character have correlated to dark fantasy genre. Dark fantasy contain horror fiction element, have dark and gloomy tone or dark and gothic atmosphere. A creepy and frightening atmosphere as feature of dark fantasy engage monsters such as werewolf, vampire and zombie (Snyder, 2005). The setting of the story in dark fantasy was separated from reality. This genre describes work of fantasy that success separated from our world to show the unreality effect (Fabrizi, 2018). Accordio (Stableford, 2009) Horror story was built in whole or just part in secondary world. The line between magical and reality wash misty. The setting of dark fantasy creates a

fantastical darkness, such as old castle, graveyard, and haunted forest.

In recent popular culture this genre developed widely, presented epic and attractive in literature and movie. Movie can be defined as a creative work that create an imagination or fiction. Fiction describes someone imagination, or dream that create characters (Nurgiyanto, 2010). Characters have the important role in the fiction. They presence something that important to the audience that author want to express (Rujito, 2013). In Fantasy fiction, character may have morally ambiguous, especially the main character. The character can’t recognize that they’re “good” or “evil” part.

Another form of film is series, series is a sequel film that continued the story. In 20th century development of series the more interested. Several work in dark fantasy genre, such as Chilling Adventures of Sabrina, The Witcher, The Umbrella Academy, and etc.

This research discusses *Wednesday Series* (2022) directed by Tim Burton. *Wednesday* comes from an adaptation of a cartoon character The Addams Family

(1938) by Charles Addams, this series from the United States. Wednesday starting airing on Netflix in November 2022. Several awards that achieved Wednesday series, such as Golden Globe Awards, MTV Movie & TV awards, and British Academy Television Awards. Another famous film that directed by Tim Burton, such as *Alice in Wonderland*(2010), *Miss Peregrine's Home for Peculiar Children*(2016), *Dark Shadows*(2012), and etc.

Wednesday series (2022) tells the story about Wednesday Addams as the main character that brought magical phenomenon and horror at the same time (Gough & Millar, 2022). Wednesday transferred into Nevermore academy, the boarding school for the outcast, because her personality like no other normies. At Nevermore Wednesday try to solve murder mystery that frightening and grimdark. This series carry darkness and gloomy atmosphere.

Wednesday's character has the psychic ability, that help her know while the others don't. The main character depicted as being able to communicate with her ancestor through her vision, Goody Addams, it means ghost. The unusual phenomenon that become main point of the story that is communicate with ghost. At the beginning, Goody just giving a sign, until Wednesday was dying, she helps Wednesday with her power. The unique one who have supernatural abilities can communicate with the dead. Plot twist of the story can blow your mind.

Several previous study that discussed dark fantastic, Casey Wayne Patterson (2022) the paper entitled *Toward a Manumissive Black Fantastic in Fandom, Fantasy, and Literature for young people: A case for the Black Hermione*. The research reveals Thomas' theory engaging Black melancholic in racial grief through fandom fiction (Patterson, 2022). The result of the paper show Rowling's state Hermione was brown eyes, frizzy hair, and very clever. Black Hermione spectacle through melancholic fandom, Hermione progresses the Harry Potter series through the same way while black or not, it is fantasy at all, imagine what internal struggle would possess to her. The hesitation moment caused life and dead struggle for her mudblood, it happen when monster rat-eaten skull came to kill. As the mudblood Hermione is not white, or mixed race, or any other ethnicity. Hermione is where the reader illustrates themselves, how they want to be seen.

Thomas (2019) in her book she examines Dark Fantastic entitled *Queen out of Place: Dark Fantastic Dreaming and the Spacetime Politics of Gwen in BBC's Merlin*. The research reveals cycle element of Dark

Fantastic, such as spectacle, hesitation, violence, and haunting. The result of the research: Gwen is spectacle through the story. She was brown skinned servant to Morgana, who dares to disapprove of the tyrannical government of the King. Her interactions King Uther and Arthur become antagonist, cause the King punish the sorcerer with the death for practicing magic as the penalty. The fantastic hesitation is showed through the conversation between different social status prince Arthur and a castle servant Gwen. After a week that Arthur lives in Gwen's home, they fall in love. Evil Gwen as the violence, she killed Arthur after twisted her mind when she trapped in Morgana's dark tower. After compromised with darkness, Gwen was dead. Merlin was haunted by Morgana, that he killed at the final first season, Morgana fell into dark magic and against Arthur and merlin, whereas Gwen haunt the text.

According to Thomas (2019) dark fantastic is critical race theory and Afropessimism. She states the dark fantastic as follow: In the Anglo-American fantastic tradition, the Dark Other is the monstrous Thing that is the root cause of hesitation, spectacle, and violence. Even all of the characters in the stories are white and blue eyes, the existence of Dark Other is always there (Thomas, 2018). Thomas (2019) describe cycle element of dark fantastic as follow, spectacle, hesitation, violence, haunting, and emancipation.

- 1 The first cycle element is spectacle, this is describing a speculative monstrous in fiction. The presence of the Dark Other create dilemma through story, writer, and audience. The darkness was needed in the fantastic, the existence of the Dark Other imagined the darkness.
- 2 The second cycle element of dark fantastic is hesitation. The Dark Other was lead to another cycle element of dark fantastic. As the source of hesitation, dilemma of the Dark Other must be resolved by the main character, is often by destruction of the Dark Other.
- 3 The dilemma guide to the third cycle element of dark fantastic, it is violence. The dilemma that present of the Dark Other must be resolved with violence. In case the Dark Other was desire in fantastic, it presence is unsettling and must be destroy the darkness with the result death of character or sacrifice. So the story can continue and haunt the ending.

- 4 The fourth cycle element of dark fantastic is haunting. When the catharsis is reached and the Dark Other is wrecked, the phenomena of death is not permanent, and the story still haunts by their absence. The existence of the Dark Other must be death, but it cannot death.
- 5 The last cycle element of dark fantastic is emancipation, this element only reached when the Dark Other was released from spectacle, hesitation, violence, and haunting. When the Dark Other has powerful abilities to release, the emergence of emancipation transforms the darkness into agent from objectified.

Nihilism is a term from Latin, *nihil* that means nothing or doesn't exist. From Oxford Dictionary, definition of nihilism is reject all of morality and religion, belief that life is nothing and has no meanings. Friedrich Nietzsche is a philosopher who states with nihilism. In his book *Thus Spoke Zarathustra* (2017), Nietzsche argued that God is dead and nihilism as destruction of all value.

There are no beliefs in general value in reality, according to nihilists. Several ways to understand nihilism concept, (a) Ethical nihilism refuses all of ethical value or social norms, (b) Political nihilism believes that all of political, religious, and social was destruction, (c) Existential nihilism believes that the world is meaningless or no purpose. Belief nothing in life, has no loyalties, and no purpose other than, refuse to social norms is concept of nihilism.

The study chooses *Wednesday series* (2022) to analyze five cycle elements of dark fantastic for several reasons. First, *Wednesday series* is one of the works directed by Tim Burton that the most watched people and get high rate and good critic in the first week of broadcast. This series presented fantasy that contains horror mystery that must be solved by the main character. The influence of the other character towards the main character is desired to be known by the writer. The second, this series can be analyzed with cycle elements of dark fantastic that never been used by student of English Language and Literature Department in State University of Surabaya. Based on the background of this study, the research question as follows:

- 1 *How is dark fantastic reflected in Wednesday series (2022)?*
- 2 *How is nihilism represented in Wednesday Series (2022)?*

RESEARCH METHOD

The method used in the analysis of *Wednesday series* is qualitative approach to describe cycle elements of dark fantastic and nihilism in supporting the genre in *Wednesday series*. This method used to analyze data that will be describing in written by words or images based on the research question before (Moelong, 2012). This paper used qualitative approach explained as follows, (1) data collection stage, (2) analysis stage, (3) data presentation stage.

This research applies the element of dark fantastic theory by Ebony Elizabeth Thomas, the framework proposed five elements of dark fantastic, such as spectacle, hesitation, violence, haunting, and emancipation. The main source of the data in this analysis takes from dialogue, narration, and scene in the series. Another source to support this research such as e-book and article journal. In obtaining the data, the writer watched the *Wednesday series* then screenshotted the dialogue and scene were related to dark fantastic and nihilism.

A procedure that the researchers did to collect of the data as follows. (a) Watch the whole of episodes in the series, total eight episodes and repeated to understand the content of the series. (b) Find the cycle elements of dark fantastic and nihilism. (c) Categorize data that show dark fantastic and nihilism and put it in the table.

After obtaining the data, the next stage is data analysis, such as (a) described dark fantastic cycle elements and nihilism in the series (b) analyzed the data that found in the series (c) make conclusions to answer the research question based on data analysis.


RESULT AND DISCUSSION

Ebony Elizabeth Thomas (2019) published her book *The Dark Fantastic: Race and the Imagination from Harry Potter to the Hunger Games* which discusses the elements of dark fantastic. Thomas explained the five elements of Dark Fantastic are spectacle, hesitation, violence, haunting, and emancipation. In *Wednesday series* there is 8 episodes. This element of Dark Fantastic' Thomas that was found in *Wednesday series*, except emancipation. Those elements explained in the following discussion.

1. Spectacle




The first element of Dark Fantastic is spectacle. Dilemma presenting the spectacle that interest to the character, writer, and then the viewer. This is called as the Dark Other. The existence of monster give rise to speculative for the viewer that defined the spectacle.

The main character, Wednesday stand with the feature of “dark” in the story. Wednesday illustrate the character as dark or gothic, her weird personality and introvert make her very attractive as long as the series. After kicked out from her the oldest school, Wednesday transferred into Nevermore Academy by her parents. This caused she trying to murder to the boys that was bullying her brother, Pugsley.

From the picture above Wednesday and her family appearance all in black, black assumed as dark. Beside of that, she’s cruel and selfish make the normies stay away from her. From the conversation above with the principal, she showing unfriendly with the other people and no polite. Wednesday tells full of mystery, horror, and dread. As dark character of the story, Wednesday presence of fantastic itself.

The emergence of monster that killing Rowan her classmates, lead this horror story until the end. This monster form of the spectacle itself, show his darkness and cruel murderer. The monster theory according to (Cohen, 1996) the presence of the monster is form of cultural. The monster itself depict eerie, dread, terror and part of dark fantasy. Besides Rowan, this monster also killed a few people with purpose and different motive.

Before Rowan success in killing Wednesday with his telekinesis, monster come and killed Rowan. Wednesday confused with that happened. Why Rowan trying to kill her and why she saved by a monster? In reality the monster stand as fantasy, define as Dark Other. The spectacle constructed by the Dark Other. The presence of the Dark Other creates a dilemma, this dilemma lead to other elements of dark fantastic.


2. Hesitation

Dark Other as the source of the Hesitation. Hesitation describe dilemma that must be resolved for the viewers and the writer, presence by Dark Other. It presence was unsettling, and finally destroy the fantastic dream. In Wednesday series it is showed Rowan’s murderer by the monster, but the case traces removed. This is make Wednesday annoyed and investigated the case with look for the evidence herself. This action caused there is correlate with disastrous destiny that said by Rowan, starting with that monster. After looking for the evidence in the ruins of old meeting house Joseph Crackstone, Wednesday find the fact that monster is human.

After look around to find the evidence, Wednesday found that Xavier drawing that monster very clearly in his painting room. Wednesday suspect Xavier is a monster she was looking for, Wednesday continued her research to proof the truth.

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On her birthday, Wednesday got surprise from Enid and their friend in Crackstone’s grave. Wednesday get a new clue for her research, when she touches the stone in graveyard, she had a psychic vision. Goody Addams guide Wednesday, so she can solve the puzzle that related to her, Crackstone, and the monster.

Kinboot is master the monster and she killed when the monster get depression. Wednesday found victim’s belongings as the evidence in Xavier’ room that make sure the monster. Xavier was arrested by the police.

When the truth almost revealed, all of the piece’s puzzle collected. After Xavier trapped dan got caught by the police, Wednesday find another truth about the monster that the real one through her vision after kissed with Tyler. Wednesday saw Tyler kill Dr. Kinboot her master is Laura Gates a.k.a. Ms. Thornhill. The effort Wednesday to caught Laura was fail, because Ms. Weems killed by Laura. The dilemma that happens because the Dark Other must be resolved.

3. Violence

Hesitation leads to the third element of dark fantastic. Violence has meaning cruel or savage, in the story the darkness must be againts so that harmony can be re-established, and story continued. The form of violence is dilemma that presence the Dark Other must be destroy to solve the problem. In this section appearance new character as the Dark Other, Crackstone. In the section before, tells the disaster will appearance between Wednesday and Crackstone.

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Wednesday was brought by Laura into Crackstone’s graveyard, sacrificed to resurrect Crackstone. Crackstone raise and kill Wednesday. Wednesday that was dying saved by Goody Addams, her ancestor. Crackstone arrive at Nevermore and trying to destroy it, but his effort failed by Wednesday. Crackstone was lost and disappeared. The werewolf in the woods, Enid defeats the monster. The destruction of Dark Other is Violence.


4. Haunting

The darkness and horror show another dilemma in the story, it called Haunting. The exists of Dark Other must dead, but it cannot dead. The Dark Other is an important part of story itself, it presents dark, dread, chaos and excitement. In the end of story Wednesday still haunts by their absence and every statement inside her head.

After the monster and Crackstone was lost, Wednesday and Enid gather back with their friends. However, death was not the end of the fantastic story. At the end of story, Tyler looks normal back after dying against the werewolf, his brought on an ambulance and bound with big chain. When everything done, this story haunt still by their absence, the Dark Other. This case presents the fourth element of the dark fantastic.


The existential of nihilism in *Wednesday series* portrayal in several scene. In the beginning, Wednesday introduced her bend in refuse to social norms. Wednesday revenge to the boys that bullying her brother, she drown piranha into boys’ swimming pool and make they are eaten.

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From the source above she is psychopathy and obsession with dead has violated the social norms. Wednesday refuse to regret that action and this associated with nihilism concept. Attempted murder is a violation of legal norms.

The next concept of nihilism in *Wednesday series* is belief nothing in life. As the main character Wednesday has own principles regarding life. She argued that social media is useless and meaningless. Not only that, Wednesday also doesn't like interacting or having any relationship because she doesn't trust with the other people.

Later discovered that Wednesday don't have gadgets or social media, she belief it's meaningless. Wednesday choose to live alone rather than live with the

society, it's not important for her. Wednesday doesn't have any friend or relationship, because she assume that destined to live alone. She belief life is nothing.

Another concept of nihilism that implied in *Wednesday series* is have no loyalties and no purpose other than. Wednesday never thought about anyone other than herself.

Wednesday lies to Enid about little birthday redo, so she can leave the dormitory to investigate Garrets mansion. In that mansion they were attacked by monsters and almost died. After back to the dorm, Enid was disappointed with Wednesday that only prioritizing her destiny rather than her friend's safety.

CONCLUSION

From the analysis above, the research explained how dark fantastic is depicted in the works. Several findings have been drawn from the analysis in this study. According to the study's finding, which were addressed in the previous chapter, the research question already answered. The question is how dark fantastic reflected in *Wednesday Series*. The research employs dark fantastic theory to reveal the phenomenon of Dark Other that occurs in the series. The data is analyzed using cycle element of dark fantastic theory. This series contain several fantasy and horror or darkness at the same time. Fantasy story combined with horror or creepy in imaginary life. This series contain several events that cannot be explained by realm, which is major feature of dark fantastic. The presence of supernatural ability, such as Wednesday's psychic, interesting gothic character, as does presence the other characters, Enid, Xavier, Bianca, and many more, who have magical talents. As the presence of the Dark Other, such as Tyler the monster, resurrection of Crackstone, bring us to feel creepy, horror and dread. The analysis of Dr. Thomas' Dark Fantastic theory's cycle elements can occur in the setting of the fantasy story. Concept of nihilism that implied in *Wednesday series* portray in several scene. Wednesday show the existential of nihilism in this series.

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
